Re: Notice of Termination – RCMP Housing and Support Services Agreement

After several years of planning, building, and collaborative work with multiple invested parties, the autonomous RCMP Detachment in Pitt Meadows is scheduled to open in 2026. In accordance with the terms of the RCMP Housing and Support Agreement between the City of Pitt Meadows and the City of Maple Ridge, I hereby provide formal written notice of the termination of this agreement, effective at midnight on March 31, 2026.

Over the past several years, both our municipalities and shared RCMP detachment have worked diligently toward the dissolution of this agreement, managing the various challenges and intricacies that arise when significant services like this are decoupled. Pitt Meadows remains committed to ensuring a smooth transition for both parties.

To facilitate a clear financial conclusion, Pitt Meadows will not incur any costs beyond March 31, 2026. Given that Maple Ridge currently bills Pitt Meadows on a quarterly basis, we request that invoicing for the final quarter be prorated to reflect services rendered up to March 31, 2026 only. Once the termination date has taken effect, any related costs that are identified must be reviewed and approved separately through a distinct process.

We appreciate the cooperation and collaboration of the City of Maple Ridge throughout this complex transition. Please do not hesitate to reach out should you require further discussion regarding outstanding obligations or transition arrangements.
